

Transit Service Routes

Use this map to find bus routes that serve destinations on and around Grounds. University students, faculty and staff may ride for free on both University Transit Service (UTS) and Charlottesville Area Transit (CAT) routes simply by showing a valid University ID when boarding.

Charlottesville Area Transit Routes

The CAT routes shown here generally run between 6:15 am and 6:45 pm Monday through Saturday, plus limited service. Route 7 also runs at night; the last 7 bus departs Fashion Square Mall for Downtown at 11:15 pm. The FREE Trolley operates Monday through Saturday from 6:40 am to midnight. The last trolley departs the Chapel for Downtown at 11:48 pm. On Sundays, the Trolley runs every half-hour from 8 am to 5:30 pm.

University Transit Service Routes

- **Northline**
- **University Loop (U-Loop)**

When classes are in session, Northline and U-Loop run from 7:30 am to 12:30 am on weekdays and noon to 12:30 am on weekends. Extended late night service runs until 2:30 am on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights. On holidays and over the summer, routes operate weekdays from 7:30 am to 12:30 am. The U-Loop operates an Inner and Outer Loop that run in opposite directions. Please refer to www.virginia.edu/uts for details.

Green Route
The Green Route operates weekdays year-round from 6:00am to 8:00pm

Colonnade Shuttle
The Colonnade Shuttle operates on a 20 minute schedule between 7:20am and 10:25pm during Full Service.

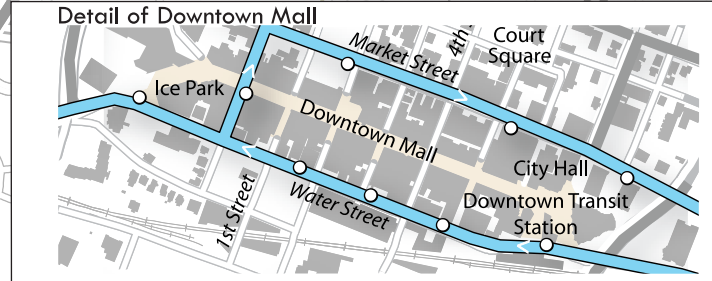
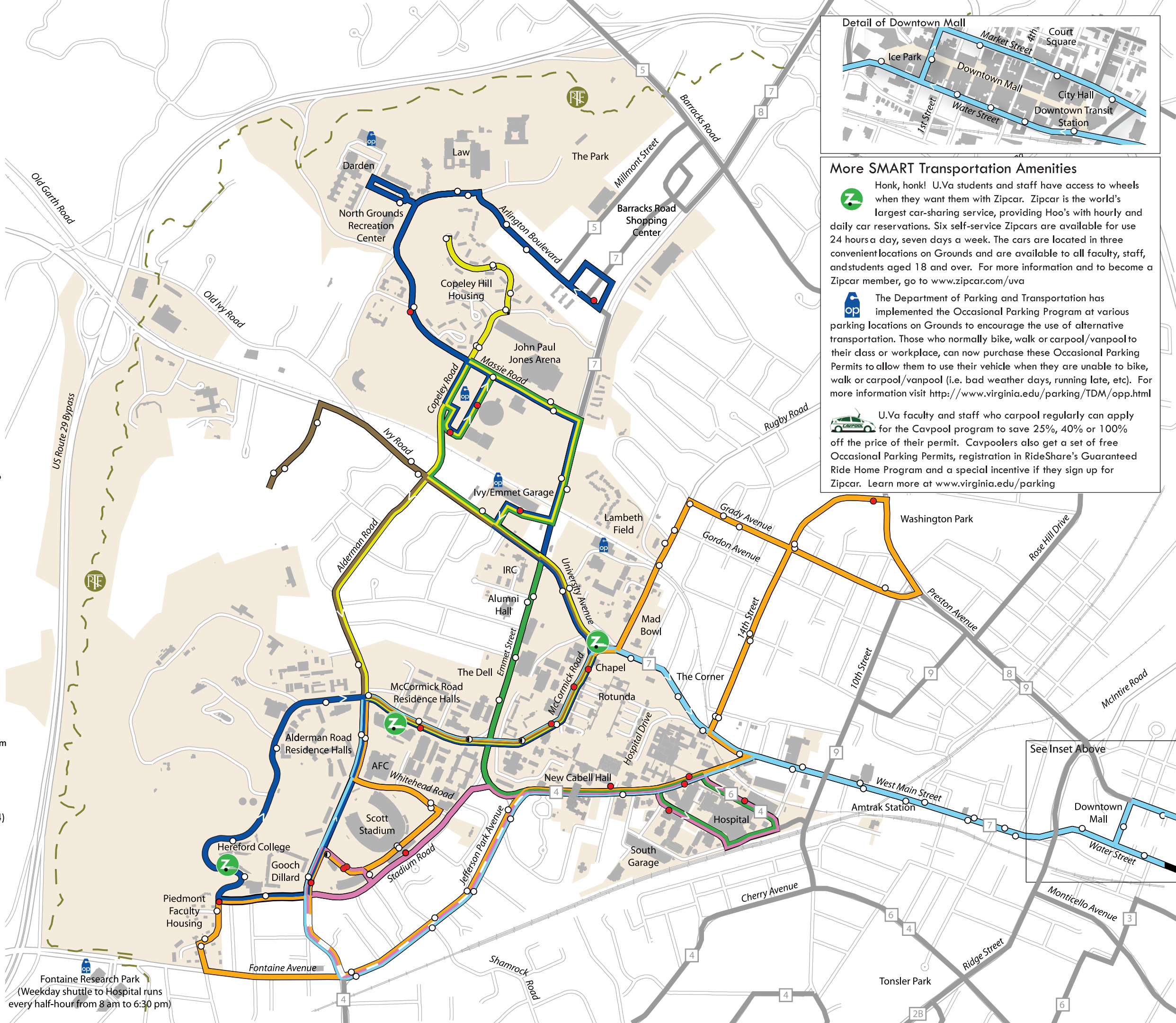
Central Grounds Shuttle
The Central Grounds Shuttle operates weekdays year-round from 6:00am to 7:55pm.

Stadium/Hospital Shuttle
The Stadium / Hospital Shuttle operates year-round during the weekday morning and evening commutes. The route serves as a direct shuttle for commuters who park at Scott Stadium and must travel to the UVA Hospital. Morning service runs from 6:00am to 9:04am and evening service operates from 2:30 pm to 8:04pm during Full Service. 20-minute service between 9:04am to 2:36pm is added during Holiday Service.

- Tips For UTS Passengers
- Please do not board the bus through the back door.
 - For your safety, use handrails while boarding the bus.
 - When requesting a stop, please pull the stop request cord early enough that the driver does not have to stop abruptly.
 - When crossing the street near a bus, cross behind rather than in front. Buses have large blind spots.
 - If you have any questions about routes or schedules, ask your driver. They'll be happy to help!

Z Honk, honk! U.Va students and staff have access to wheels when they want them with Zipcar. Zipcar is the world's largest car-sharing service, providing Hoo's with hourly and daily car reservations. Six self-service Zipcars are available for use 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The cars are located in three convenient locations on Grounds and are available to all faculty, staff, and students aged 18 and over. op The Department of Parking and Transportation has implemented the Occasional Parking Program at various parking locations on Grounds to encourage the use of alternative transportation. Those who normally bike, walk or carpool/vanpool to their class or workplace, can now purchase these Occasional Parking Permits to allow them to use their vehicle when they are unable to bike, walk or carpool/vanpool (i.e. bad weather days, running late, etc). Carpool U.Va faculty and staff who carpool regularly can apply for the Cavpool program to save 25%, 40% or 100% off the price of their permit. Cavpoolers also get a set of free Occasional Parking Permits, registration in RideShare's Guaranteed Ride Home Program and a special incentive if they sign up for Zipcar.
